Dear Neighbors:

This month's meeting of the Board of Trustees will be held on **Monday, March 25, 2019 at 8:00 p.m.** We welcome you to come and join us at that time. Your input and involvement is always welcome.

The annual Village tax bill was mailed at the end of February. If you pay your taxes directly and have not received your tax bill, please contact the Village Office. To avoid interest penalties your **Village taxes must be paid no later than April 1, 2019.** Additionally, we ask that you please remind your gardener that permits must be renewed at Village Hall for the 2019 season. Only those gardeners holding valid permits will be permitted to work in the Village.

With respect to the Woodmere Club, we continue to actively monitor any developments in the process. The property owner has submitted documents to the Nassau County Planning Commission, and the Planning Commission issued a lead agency coordination request letter to involved agencies, including the Village. This is the first step in the application process. The Village has submitted an initial response to the Planning Commission request, and will continue to vigorously pursue the rights of our residents and the Village. As of yet, no subdivision application has been filed with the Village for the lots in the Village. As you may know, the owner of the Woodmere Club has commenced litigation concerning the development moratorium imposed by the Village. Our responsibility is to the residents of the Village to ensure that we stay on top of the process and address matters which may impact our quality of life in the Village. We will keep you updated as the process unfolds.
