

Ralph L. Limberger

1932 – 1996

Ralph L. Limberger, age 64 of Pigeon, passed away suddenly on Wednesday, March 20 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon.

He was born in Winsor Township on January 23, 1932, the son of the late William and Barbara (Wing) Limberger. On September 17, 1951 he was united in marriage to Donna M. Richmond in Pigeon. She survives him.

Mr. Limberger graduated from Pigeon High School in 1950. He was a United States Army veteran, discharged in 1954 as Corporal. He was employed by the Cooperative Elevator Co. Service Station in Pigeon for 44 years, retiring in October, 1993.

He was a member of the American Legion Theron W. Atwood, Sr. Post #7 in Caro, and a former member of the Pigeon Lions Club. He was past president of the Pigeon Chamber of Commerce, and he actively supported and promoted the Pigeon Farmers Festival. Mr. Limberger enjoyed woodworking and collecting toy tractors, and especially loved to tease his friends.

Surviving him are his wife, Donna M., Pigeon; his daughter and son-in-law, Joann and John Schaefer, Pigeon; his grandson, Matthew Schaefer; a sister, Florence (Austin) Rogers, Pigeon; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a brother, Roland Limberger.

Funeral Services will be conducted at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 23 from the Pigeon River Mennonite Church. Rev. Tom Beachy, pastor, and Rev. Luke Yoder will officiate. Burial will be in Grand Lawn Cemetery, Pigeon.
