The Chronicle article is an update to this website's posting of August 24, 2015. The 2015 posting discussed active legislation which had largely concluded by the time the Chronicle article was published in February 2016.

A couple of paragraphs in the Chronicle article have additional notes below.

Actually, Block has paid \$ 1.00 toward the judgment for contempt of court, Snohomish County Superior Court Case 11-2-09706-2. She has not paid for any of the other judgments against her.
