QMHP Counselor

Position Description

An ideal QMHP Counselor is client focused and passionate about providing person-centered driven services within sound therapeutic practices. The QMHP will possess a QMHP- A/C registration with the Virginia Board of Counseling with experience in providing mental health services to children and/adults. The QMHP Counselor will be responsible for providing a variety of interventions in the client's home and community as appropriate and necessary; based on their individual mental, behavioral, and/or emotional needs. The QMHP Counselor will report to the Clinical Supervisor of the Program and the Program Director.

Position Qualifications

A QMHP will possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree in human services or other related fields. Have current registration as a QMHP- Adult with the VA Board of Counseling or a QMHP- Child. A QMHP Counselor will have familiarity with community mental health resources; ability to build rapport with clients; strong leadership and problem-solving skills; experience in conflict resolution; compassionate and caring demeanor; and have excellent written and verbal communication skills.

Position Responsibilities

- Establish open lines of communication for individuals with mental/behavioral/emotional issues.
- Provide direct, Intensive In-Home/Mental Health Skill Building Services to identified youth and/or adults
- Facilitate therapeutic sessions for clients and their family for immediate/preventive needs
- Develop and implement individual treatment plans.
- Establish treatment goals and milestones with clients.
- Prepare daily progress notes, quarterly reports, and other pertinent documentation.
- Educate clients and families on prevention programs and/or therapeutic treatments.
- Acts as an advocate on behalf of the client and their family in relation to service needs.
- Facilitate referrals to other healthcare or counseling professionals.
- Collaborate with additional treatment providers and placement agencies.
- Available for 24-hour crisis intervention and family support.
