## ARRIVAL AND CANAL TOUR

MONDAY 1.21.19

Arrival into Tocumen International Airport and motorcoach to Panama City. Guided tour to Casco Antigua. Participants will visit the main attraction in Panamá, the Miraflores Locks Visitors Center.

## OPENING MASS

TUESDAY 1.22.19

Morning at leisure (or guided city tour if it did not happen on day of arrival). Afternoon and evening participation in the opening of the World Youth Day in Panamá.

## CATECHESIS

WEDNESDAY 1.23.19

WYD participants, organized by language groups, will have catechesis sessions with bishops from all over the world. The sessions will take place in church, school, auditoriums, and sports centers in Panamá.

Morning catechesis and WYD activities. Arrival of Pope Francis and welcoming address.

## STATIONS OF THE CROSS

FRIDAY 1.25.19

Morning catechesis and WYD activities. Participants will take part in the Stations of the Cross.

## OVERNIGHT VIGIL

SATURDAY 1.26.19

Participants will arrive at the site for the overnight vigil. Eucharistic Adoration will begin after the arrival of Pope Francis. An address will be made by the Holy Father.

## PAPAL MASS

SUNDAY 1.27.19

Pope Francis will concelebrate Mass with thousands of bishops and priests. He will address the young people, sending them out to the world to witness to their faith, as the Lord did with His apostles. Participants will return to Panamá for a farewell dinner cruise on the Panamá Canal.

## DEPART FOR HOME

MONDAY 1.28.19

With renewed faith in Christ and the Church, participants return home to share their gifts and strengths with their local community.
