Telecommunicator Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

The Oklahoma Chapter of the National Emergency Number Association (OklaNENA) Telecommunicator Scholarships are available to any telecommunicator, call taker or dispatcher with at least three (3) years of experience in Emergency Communications. Industry partners or other vendor personnel are not eligible for this award, nor are previous recipients. The applicant must also be a NENA member in good standing.

To be eligible for the scholarship, you must complete and submit the scholarship application and provide a current resume.

The NENA member course fee will be paid by OklaNENA. Any additional costs associated with materials or retaking the course will be paid by the applicant.

OklaNENA's Telecommunicator Scholarship program was established in the fall of 2024 to promote professionalism, ensure awareness of current issues and developments in the 9-1-1 profession and to encourage personal growth.
