MEMBER NEWS

At the June membership meeting there was discussion regarding the Clubroom bar cooler condition, repairs and replacement was a topic regarding last year Northside stated they couldn't evaluate its life span because of its age. One condenser is operating the entire thing. If we wait until it goes down, finding parts could be problematic. Last year Northside recommended new lines, a new compressor and 2 new condensers. The membership voted in favor of obtaining quotes and the Board followed up on this.

A current bid was received by Northside with an increase from last year's quote due to parts increase as well as expected 8 - 12 week order time for parts. The Board would ask the Membership to consider a motion to proceed with the estimated work not exceed \$9500. The bid includes air cooled indoor condenser, 2 evaporator and TXV's, lineset, controls, refrigerant and labor as well as the electrical work needed. With the 8-12 week parts procurement, we would like to get this going now so we can have installation before fall. This project is slated to be on the July 3, 2023 Membership Meeting agenda for consideration.

The Life Membership and By Laws Committees are recommending amending our current by laws regarding the number of memberships granted annually. This was presented and discussed at the June membership meeting and will be voted on at the July 3 rd membership meeting.

Current and proposed changes:

Article III. Membership

C. Class 3 Life Membership

A: Any member that has been extraordinarily involved in the benefit of the club and has a minimum of 20 uninterrupted years of membership shall be eligible for a life membership. A sponsor other than the applicant must submit application by July 31 st to the Life Membership Committee. Application must include a history and resume of the member's involvement with the club. A maximum of 4 life memberships in this may be awarded each year.

Proposed Change: A maximum of 2 life memberships.

A2: Any member with 30 years of continuous uninterrupted membership may apply for a life membership. Application must be submitted to the Life Membership Committee by July 31 st and must include a history of the member's involvement with the club. A maximum of 2 life memberships in this category may be awarded each year.

Article XIII. Amendments

Proposed Addition:

Section 3: It is the responsibility of any committee chairperson or any general member to communicate with any other committees that may be affected by proposed changes to Club Rules or By Laws prior to presentation to the Board and membership.
