Four, this is a great time for Christian service, especially doing things for our older generation. One simple example is writing cards to our church members who are in a nursing facility or homebound, what an encouragement that would be to them.

One last thing, the church continues to incur cost whether anyone attends or not (like a very large insurance bill due in two weeks). So please remember to mail or drop off your tithe checks to the office.
