In addition to the provisions of the City of Deary Burn Ordinance found under Chapter 8.04 of the City of Deary Municipal Code, this Permit Holder agrees to abide by the following terms and conditions:

- 1. This permit does not entitle the holder thereof to build an open fire in conditions where it is unsafe to do so, such as when the wind is blowing excessively.
- 2. All fires must be carefully guarded with lawn hose or other sufficient water source.
- 3. No fire shall be left burning during the night without direct supervision.
- 4. No fire shall be built within 50 feet of any building.
- 5. Permit Holder shall provide Fire Department or City Clerk with a fire suppression plan.
- 6. For advice on Fire Prevention call the Fire Department at 877-1515.
- 7. The grant of this permit shall in no way relieve the Permit Holder from the consequences, damages, or claims resulting from such burning.
- 8. This permit does not relieve the Permit Holder of the responsibility of using fire safe practices nor from getting a permit from any other agency that may require such.
- 9. All permits issued shall be displayed while the open burning is in progress.
- 10. The fire department shall have the authority to forbid, restrict, or suspend any and all burning when the Fire Chief or authorized representative of the Fire Department has determined that conditions are unfavorable or hazardous for outdoor fires.

There is no fee for this permit, however if a fire gets out of hand and the fire department must be contacted a misdemeanor charge may occur, and the Permit Holder may be liable for all damages.

THE PERMIT HOLDER MUST HAVE THIS PERMIT ON HAND AT THE TIME AND LOCATION OF THE BURNING.
