

RULES FOR USE OF CONNEAUT LAKE BARK PARK

1. In Pennsylvania dog owners are liable and assume legal responsibility for any damages, or injury to persons or other dogs, or property caused or inflicted by you and/or your dog.
 - a. Owners are responsible to supervise their dog's behavior and play at all times
2. It is the owners responsibility to make sure their dog(s) are current on all required health clearances including annual fecal and bordatella.
3. Owners must clean up after their dogs. Plastic bags and trash cans are available in the off-leash areas and also several places on the Bark Park property.
4. Children under the age of 10 are not allowed in any off-leash area. Children under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
5. All dogs must pass a temperament screening to use the off-leash areas.
6. All dogs must be on a leash when getting out of a car and when inside any of the Bark Park buildings.
7. Dogs are expected to be on a leash and under control when near any of the outside off-leash areas. Carry one leash per dog at all times when on the Bark Park property.
8. If others are waiting to use an off-leash area and the dogs are not able to play with other dogs, limit your time in an area to 30 minutes.
9. Dogs with dangerous behavior are prohibited from off-leash areas.
10. Do not leave your dog unattended when using any of the Bark Park facilities.
11. No more than two dogs per adult in an off-leash area with other dogs in attendance. If an owner has three or more dogs, they are permitted to exclusively use an off-leash area.
12. Dogs must wear collars in off-leash areas and when using the Bark Park property.
 - a. Pinch collars and choke collars are not permitted in off-leash areas, only buckle collars are permitted
13. Female dogs in heat are prohibited from off-leash areas
14. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages are allowed on Bark Park property.
15. No smoking in off-leash areas
16. Puppies must be older than four months to use any off-leash area.
17. Do not bring a dog to the Bark Park if they show any signs of possible illness
18. Your dog should be responsive to basic commands.
19. People food or drink is not allowed in off-leash areas.
20. No more than 10 medium/large dogs in large dog area or 8 small dogs in small dog area at one time.
