

# Coquitlam 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

## Mini Soccer Tournament – Sunday, Aug 7, 2016

Location: 1299 Pinetree Way, Coquitlam - Town Centre

One day 5V5 tournament (4 players & a goalie) open for all levels players / teams .

Futsal size field (on turf) and futsal rules will apply on our mini soccer tournament

The registration fee for adult team (17 year old and up) is \$80.00 and for kids (10 to 13 year old) is \$60.00

**Winning teams will receive prizes!**

### Tournament Format:

- All teams will play on mini-fields with 5 players, including a goalie.
- Four games guarantee for each team, with group stage (round-robin) followed by a knock-out.
- There will be 2 fifteen minute with 5 minute half-time break and unlimited substitutions.
- A team may have a maximum of 8 players and a minimum of 5 players.
- No shoulder charge and no slide tackling in our mini soccer tournament – no offsite rules.
- A player who gets 2 yellow cards will result him not to play for 4 minutes, his team playing less player.
- Any abuse towards a referee will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the tournament.

### All teams participating in the Tournament must abide by the Fair Play Code:

- Play for the fun of it and the love of soccer. Be generous when you win; be graceful when you lose.
- Always be fair, no matter what the cost. Treat others as you yourself would like to be treated.
- Obey the Laws of the Game. Accept all decisions made by game officials or referee with good grace.
- Only team coaches and players are allowed on the field. Players should wear uniform with numbers.

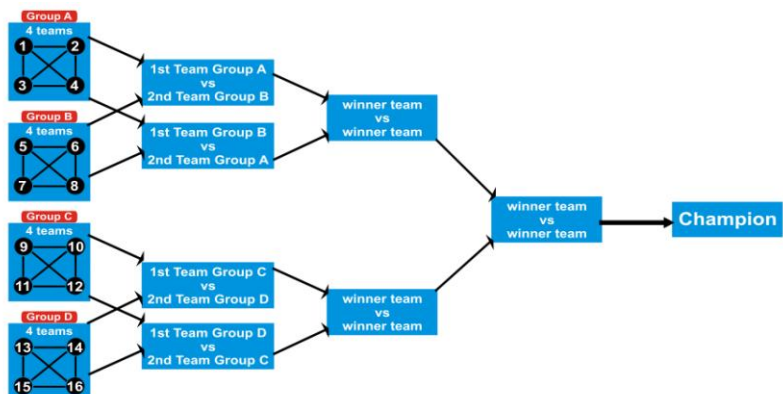
**Points will be awarded as follows: 3 points for a win - 1 point for tie - 0 point for loss.**

In case of tie, winner will be decided by head to head record. If still tied, team with most goals. If still tied, penalty kicks shootout to decide the winner!

### Combination Tournament

Our tournament scheduled for group stage (round-robin) followed by a knock-out. Each team plays three games before possibility of elimination. Teams finishing 1<sup>st</sup> in each group will play the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed team in the next phase of tournament.
