Rating recognition awards to be distributed in June

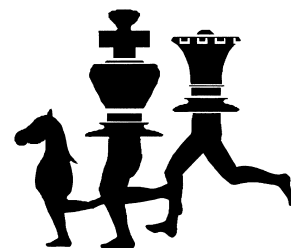

(Limited enrollment of 12 students, priority to full-day) (Full-Day players bring a bag lunch; a.m./p.m. healthy snacks provided to all)

- Two instructors on hand so both beginners and experienced players rated up to 1200 will benefit from these camps.
- Ages 8 and above recommended; younger students may be accepted if older sibling also enrolled or if they are already experienced players who have proven themselves able to take classes.
- Raw beginners not knowing legal moves or basic concepts such as checkmate must first be evaluated at least two weeks prior to their first camp. The evaluation will also include basic chess teaching materials which should be studied prior to first day of camp. Evaluations are FREE and last about 30 minutes; additional time for an actual lesson in conjunction can be arranged.
- Students who have NOT been involved in a Roving ChessNuts school program or class or previous camp (or not having a national chess rating) should also be evaluated so we can better know what help they need in developing their chess skills and make sure they do understand game concepts.
- Weather permitting each camp day will feature 60 to 90 minutes of either soccer skills and play or running/fitness activities and testing. Students should bring water bottle, appropriate footwear and outdoor wear. Water cooler, fridge, microwave available.
- All participants must sign and abide by a code of conduct related to sportsmanship, behaviour and chess etiquette.
- All new participants will receive a national Chess'n Math rating, a discount voucher for entry in a scholastic chess tournament and a camp chess souvenir.

Full Day: \$45 plus GST FULL WEEK \$180 plus GST

Half-Day: \$28 plus GST FULL WEEK Half Days: \$115 plus GST

Family Discounts applied for 2 or more students; Discounts also available for three or four full or half days

Payment can be made by cheque, credit card, debit card or cash and must be arranged at time of enrollment.
