## 1915 - 1994

John J. Kleido, 78 of Pigeon, passed away Saturday, Feb. 6 at his home, following an apparent heart attack.

He was born April 27, 1915 in Eldon, son of the late Stanley and Stella (Pawlowicz) Kleido. A veteran of World War I, serving in the U.S. Army. Mr. Kleido was a member of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church, Pigeon.
