

PASSING RULES



A & B GROUPS (BEGINNER & INTERMEDIATE) — PASSING ON THE <u>LEFT SIDE</u> ONLY – WITH A POINT BY!

C & I GROUPS (ADVANCED & INSTRUCTORS) — PASSING ON EITHER SIDE – WITH A POINT BY!

- Passing is with a Point By Only. One car per point-by.
- **Car being passed**: Point the car by on the left side (or right side if Advanced or Instructor). Stay on your line. Back off on the throttle as needed to let the passing car by but don't brake.
 - **Only give a point-by where you are comfortable being passed.** If the car behind you chooses not to pass when pointed them by, they may not be comfortable passing you there. Check your mirrors and point the car by at the next opportunity.
- **Passing car:** It is your responsibility to complete a safe pass by the start of the braking zone for the next turn.
 - If you are not comfortable taking the pass, don't take it. Wait for the next point-by.
 - You will go off-line to take the pass. Be aware that you may be off-line when starting the next turn, so adjust your speed accordingly.
- Passing must be completed by the start of the braking zone for the next turn.
