Rose M. Krohn, 87 of Elkton, passed away unexpectedly Friday evening, Jan. 27 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, after suffering an acute heart attack.

She was born July 21, 1907 in Pigeon, daughter of the late William and Bertha (Muhme) Stein. She was united in marriage to Carl Krohn, Sr. on July 4, 1929 in Detroit. He preceded her in death on Aug. 13, 1984.

She and her husband started the Elkton Nursery in 1940. In 1967, they retired and turned the business over to their son. She was a lifelong member of the Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church and Ladies Aid, Elkton.

She was preceded in death by two brothers, William Stein and Carl Stein, Sr.

Funeral services will be conducted Tuesday, Jan. 31 at 11 a.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church, Elkton. Rev. Eugene Andrus, pastor, will officiate with burial in Riverside Cemetery, Elkton.
