Charles L. Burson, 83, of Port Austin passed away March 18, 2008 in Weeki Wachee, Fla. Mr. Burson was born in Mount Vernon, Ohio in 1924. He lived in Ypsilanti from 1952-1976, and from 1976-2008 in Port Austin and Weeki Wachee, Fla. He will be remembered by most as a huge football fan and a very loyal Ohio State Buckeye fan.

Mr. Burson was a member of the United Protestant Church of Port Austin and was also a lifetime member of the Michigan Masons, Shriners, and the Ohio Elks Club. He was a member of the American Legion and the Disabled Veterans of America, and also served in World War II Paratroopers 82nd Division.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Ruth F. Burson, of Port Austin and Weeki Wachee, Fla.; a daughter Sharlee Sylvester (Lee) of Southfield and Port Austin; and a grandson, Brian Vinson of Holly; and many dear friends.
