- You must be registered by **Friday February 28th at 7pm** – or you will not play in the first round. Players not registered will be paired for the second round and will receive a ½ point bye for the first round. Register at www.spacecoastchess.org/
- First round starts at 9:00 am. All players should be on site and checked in by 8:45 am.
- **\$20 if registered** by Friday February 28th at **7 PM**. \$25 if not registered by **7 PM** (walk-ins). Register at www.spacecoastchess.org/
- First time **Brevard County** players only pay \$5- If this is your very first tournament you won't have to pay full price, however, you must register and purchase a USCF membership.
- USCF membership required- This must be purchased in advance from the USCF- <https://secure2.uschess.org/webstore/member.php>
- Tournament fees will be collected at the tournament site (you cannot pay online). Cash or check. Make entry fee checks payable to Space Coast Scholastic Chess.

There will be Six sections: K-1, K-3, K-6, K-12, Scholastic Experts, and Scholastic Masters. All sections play 5 rounds. SE is for players rated from 1000-1399. SM is for players rated between 1400-1800. All games played at G25;d5 (Each player gets 25 minutes w/ 5 second delay) except SE & SM section games (G40;d5). No elimination. A half point bye may be requested for rounds 1-5 at registration. Latest rating will be used for pairings and prizes.

INDIVIDUAL & TEAM TROPHIES -Trophies to top 3 players in K-1 and K-12, Top 5 in K-3 and K-6, and Top player in Scholastic Experts and Scholastic Masters. Biggest upset trophy in K-3, K-6 and SE. Plaques to Top 3 teams in K-3 and K-6. Medals awarded to first-time players. Top 4 players count for team trophies.
