A full day program offered to high school students with disabilities. Students participate in our academic Transition Program at the TEC Education Center. Students will also volunteer their time at various community volunteer sites to gain meaningful work skills. The students will attend from 8:30AM-2:30PM. Our educational team of a Certified Special Education Teacher and support staff will meet the goals of each student's IEP. Staff will also lead students to learn and develop the necessary skills for employment after high school.



Eligibility Requirements

- Students are referred to our school by their home school district and the student's IEP team
- Students must be willing to actively participate in both transition and academic services
