

EU: Interconnection of national insolvency registers

(July 7, 2014)

On July 7, 2014 the European Commission launched an EU-wide interconnection of national insolvency registers by linking up databases from seven member states. The seven member states of which the national insolvency registers have been linked up are: the Czech Republic, Germany, Estonia, The Netherlands, Austria, Romania and Slovenia. More countries are expected to join at a later stage.
