28th Annual Big Horn Basin Muzzleloaders Primitive Shoot Brewster Ranch, Ten Sleep, WY August 2-3, 2014

The 28th Annual Big Horn Basin Muzzleloader Primitives Shoot was held out at the Brewster's Ranch on the Lower Nowood, August 2-3, 2014. We had 22 registered shooters plus a large contingent of others who showed up to visit and watch the shoot. 21 of the registered shooters braved the primitive range. The club provided hamburgers which Tom and Sherry Brewster cooked up. I provided fresh sweet corn from Stiver's Garden here in Worland. Other club members and shooters provided potluck fixings. We probably had around 30-35 for the meal with plenty of leftovers for lunch for everyone on Sunday.

It wasn't quite as hot as last year, maybe 90-95 degrees, still warm on the primitive range. We didn't even set up the shade covers this year; it was pleasant under the trees. Range opened at 9:00 am for shooting on the paper and primitive range. Range was closed around 5:00 pm to get ready of the potluck dinner. So the few that spent the night sat around and visited. Sunday the ranges were opened again at 9:00 am.
