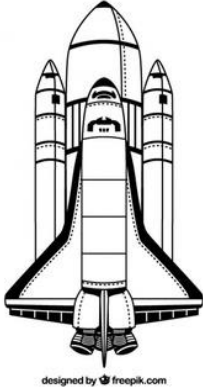

Hi Quilters,

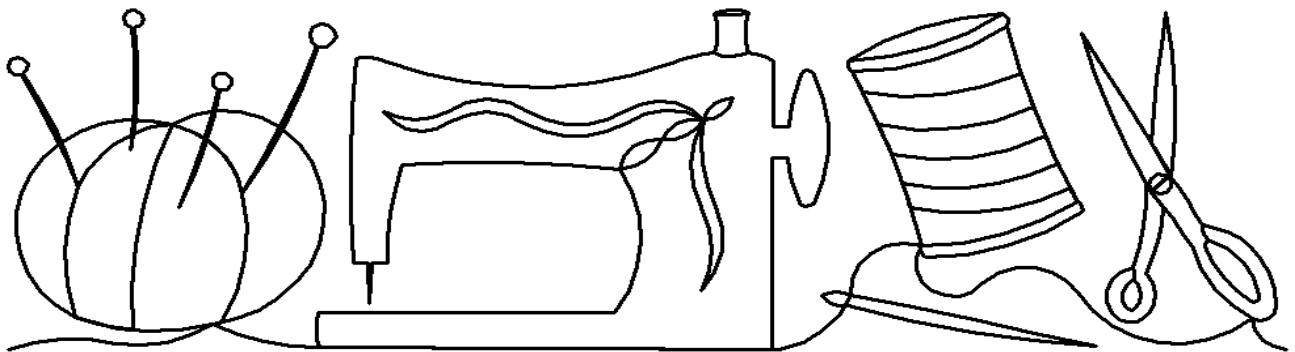
Summer is coming to an end, and it's time to think about New Officers. The Guild needs to have Officers in order to continue. Please consider serving.

The show will include: door prizes, demos, quilts on display, vendors and an auction. you can even take a quilt there for an appraisal. (may have to set up in advance).

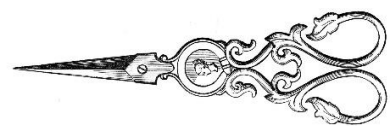
The shop in Lake Mary will offer us a demo and discount on all items in the store, it's a lovely shop we have been there several times to visit.

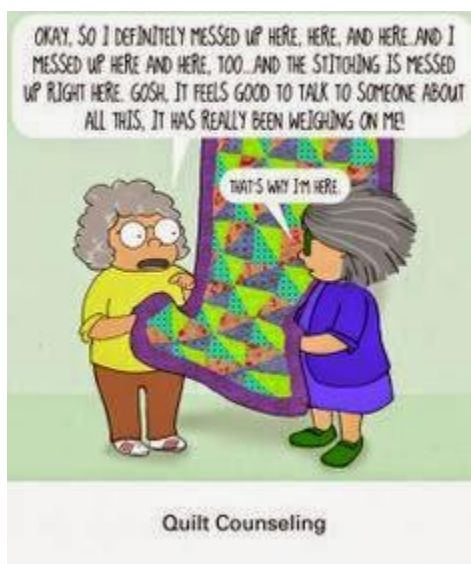
