


RE	MUSIC	PE	SCIENCE	
<p>This half term we will be looking at the question: 'Why do Christians celebrate Christmas?'</p> <p>This will involve retelling the Christmas story, and learning about the traditions Christians have at this time of year.</p>	<p>We will be continuing to explore the beats and rhythms of different pieces of music, and how we can use our bodies to represent the sounds we can hear.</p>	<p>As PE overview</p>	<p>We will be looking at 'Our Senses'. The children will be introduced to the concept of five senses that will help them to find out about the world around them and link those senses to particular parts of their body. They will name simple parts of the body and draw and label a life size version of themselves or a class mate. Each sense will be explored by children as they answer a variety of science questions.</p>

<p>We will be continuing with Read Write Inc to support children in learning letters and sounds. This knowledge will then be extended upon to develop writing and reading skills.</p> <p>Other literacy based activities will be looking at stories with familiar settings for example, Dogger. We will be writing about the main events and settings and coming up with our own adaptations for the story.</p>			<p>We will be creating props and backdrops that will be used in our production of Dogger, using different mediums, for example; paint, tissue paper, collage, chalk.</p>	<p>We will be learning how to read maps and the meaning of different symbols that can be found on maps. We will then learn how to use a key, and create our own map for the school. Children will make maths links by using co-ordinates to locate different places.</p>
