Dorper/White Dorper Breeding Show Rules

- 1. All breeding Sheep must be accompanied by a current (within 30 days) Certificate of Veterinary Inspection that meets all state requirements, issued by a certified veterinarian.
- 2. Each exhibitor will be restricted to two entries in any single class and one in any group class.
- 3. All entries must be mailed to the following address.

- 4. Sheep that are not entered in the show will not be permitted on the grounds.
- 5. Bedding will be available for sale at the livestock office or you may bring your own. Straw is NOT permitted.
- 6. NO ANIMALWILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS WITHOUT PROPER RELEASE.
- 7. All breeding sheep must be registered in the recognized flock books of their respective breeds. Sheep not carrying proper ear identification at time of showing will be barred from competition. The official certificate of registration must be presented, and association ear tags or tattoos must correspond with the certificate. Applications of transfer or pending registrations will not be accepted.
- 8. All exhibitors must be members in good standing with the ADSBS with paid dues for 2019.
- 9. All entries must be properly sheared and washed for the show. Animals showing signs of ringworm, fungus or other commutable diseases will not be allowed to show and must be removed from show grounds.

- 10. To be eligible to show in group classes, the animal must be shown in a single class. There is not an entry fee for pair or group classes but please fill out a separate entry form.
- 11. Sheep must be registered in the name of the exhibitor (or ranch name) and must have been owned by the exhibitor prior to August 1, 2019.
- 12. Dorpers and White Dorpers will show in separate classes. Classes are listed below.
