- 1. Photographs must be 5 x 7 or 8 x 10 inch and matted or mounted on <u>heavy poster board</u>. <u>Photos will not be accepted on heavy paper.</u>
- 2. The 5" x 7" photo must be matted or mounted on 8" x 10" board and 8" x 10" photos must be matted or mounted on 11" x 14" mat or heavy poster board.
- 3. To be considered for Best of Show, the photo must be an 8' x 10" matted with a 11" x 14" board.
- 4. Framed photos will not be accepted.
- 5. All photos except Fair History must be made after July 23, 2018
- 6. The same photo cannot be duplicated in other divisions.
- 7. Points will be awarded: Blue- 4, Red 3, and White 2.
- 8. No identifying words may be submitted on the photo or the mat. It is recommended that dates not be on front of the photos.

State regulations prohibit the exhibition of Eagle feathers or bird nests in collections.

- 8. No printing or mounting of entries is required. Photos will be uploaded digitally.

- 9. Edited or Photoshopped photos are welcome in any class. The same subject photo cannot be entered in a Black and White Class and duplicated in the Color Class.
- 10. Each individual photographer will determine the appropriate category for each of their photos. For instance, a photo of an interesting insect on a beautiful flower could be entered into the Plants and Flowers category or the Nature category, or it may be entered separately in both categories. Fulton County Fair officials reserves the right to move any photo if it is deemed to have been entered into an incompatible category.
- 11. No identifying marks may appear on the image such as dates. watermarks or logos.
- 12. Entries will be screened by the contest committee and may be disqualified for one or more of the following reasons: (a) Failure to strictly adhere to contest rules and regulations; (b) Acceptability of image subject matter; (c) Photo is either too large or too small to be displayed.

AWARDS:

Ribbons and cash awards will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place entries in each class. The amount of the cash award will be determined by the sponsor. One Best of Show Cash Award will be awarded to the overall winner in Division 204. Exhibitors will be asked to print the winning entries to be displayed during the week of the fair--July 23-28.
