Re: City of Goliad New Water Well

Goliad County Groundwater Conservation District (GCGCD) wants to extend our support and is committed to working with the City of Goliad to obtain a Water Well Operating Permit as soon as possible for the new water well to be located on Ward Street in the City of Goliad. GCGCD has reviewed Goliad Ward Street Well Final Design that was approved February 13, 2020. It is important for GCGCD to provide information to help explain and clarify some objectives due to the complex nature of this application. Based on the review of final well design and GCGCD rules, the below addresses areas that need to be included in the operating permit. A copy of this letter will be attached to the operating permit application to complete the comments and special provisions section and to complete the normal rate of production information on the operating permit application.

It is understood that the City of Goliad Certificate of Necessity (CCN) now includes 1,030 acres. This includes the portion that was added several months ago in the northern part of the CCN. Considering the CCN acreage, depth of the well, and screening depths, by district rules this provides the City of Goliad a maximum allowable of 515-acre foot of water per year. The City of Goliad has two existing wells that hold a Historic Use Allocation (HUAC) from which those two wells allocations will be deducted from the maximum allowable of 515 ac/ft/yr. The combined total of the two existing wells HUAC is 417 ac/ft/yr. Also, GCGCD has located 20 private wells that are located within the City of Goliad's CCN. An allocation has been given to these existing wells to be deducted from the maximum allowable allocation. GCGCD has figured on a family of four at 110 gallons per day per person is approximately 9.86 ac/ft/yr. With all of the deductions of allocations this leaves the remaining allocation of 88.14 ac/ft/yr that the new well can be permitted for to add to the existing system. However, because GCGCD is considering the wells as a three well system, each well will not be restricted to the given HUAC or permitted allocation to each individual well. The "system" will be permitted up to 505 ac/ft/yr, with the new water well located on Ward Street to be restricted to a maximum production of 275 ac/ft/yr. The 275 ac/ft/yr is the maximum allowable production for this well based on GCGCD rules using minimum screening depths to maximum pumping gpm at 95% pump availability.

In addressing the normal rate of production of the new well, GCGCD feels that the well will have a variable intermittent rate depending on the use, tank levels, etc. A fixed rate should not be included on the application and should be listed as such.

In order to protect existing private water wells within the City of Goliad's CCN, it will be the City of Goliad's responsibility to mitigate any damage or negative effects that private water well owners within the CCN area may encounter.

Lastly, GCGCD request that a copy of the City of Goliad's Drought Contingency Plan be accompanied with the operating permit application, as well as the pump test results and water quality analysis results be provided to GCGCD as they become available. The Operating Permit may be granted with the understanding that a pump test will be done and the results provided to GCGCD prior to commercial operation of the well. Please note annual reporting of water pumped will be required for the well system (total of the three wells) and also the portion that is pumped from the new well.

Feel free to complete and return the Operating Permit Application and the operating permit fee as soon as possible so that we can proceed with the permit hearing process. Permit fees are based on the total gpm produced by the pump. According to the well design the well will have a maximum but variable discharge rate of 600 gpm. Fees associated with this rate will be a onetime fee of \$600.00. Please note that a 10-day notice of Public Hearing is required to be posted prior to the hearing date. Public Hearings are held on the same times as normal monthly meetings every third Monday of the month at 5:00 p.m. at 118 S. Market St., Goliad, TX., at the District office. The completed Operating Permit Application, Drought Contingency Plan, any requested documentation that is available, and onetime fee of \$600.00 should be received no later than 12 days prior to GCGCD's regular meeting date to allow GCGCD processing time.


