PERMANENT S GAUGE LAYOUT

By end of day Thursday, March 24, we should be very close to having the lower level track complete and operational. (Excluding installing turnouts)

A meeting was held this evening to decide what we will be using to operate the layout. The group decided on Lionel's Cab1 or Cab1L system (whichever we can obtain) along with a backup system consisting of conventional transformer power supplies.

It is quite possible that we will be able to run a train on the layout this Saturday, March 26, while we are open to the public. This is after just three weeks of work. Workers are Javen Schmucker, Ron McLeran, Troy Brown, Mike Miller, Mike Shockey, and Rich Parsons.


















Permanent S Gauge Layout Continued:

- 2. Of the five PS2 engines, one will not read into DCS; several have low or dead batteries; one has degraded sound quality.
- 3. Of the non-powered Genesis, one of the MTH & one of the Williams have a sheared-off truck ... 'assume conley weld or like will fix it up.
- 4. The roster was purchased new in the 2001-2005 timeframe; most still have their distinctive maroon boxes.
