Statement of Scriptural Affirmation

We believe that the King James Version is the Word of God and that the doctrines and theological positions in this version are unique.

Scriptural Affirmation

We affirm, by confirmation of the Spirit of God, that the King James Bible is the anointed Word of God, possessing all the attributes of God the Son; that It has the power to convince us of sin (John 16:8), to save our souls (James 1:21), and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1John 1:9); that the Word alone has the power and authority to deliver us from the reality of an eternal hell, into the Mercies and Grace of God's Salvation.

We affirm that doctrines and theological positions are established by distinctions in terminology in the Scripture of the King James Bible - and that these distinctions, in totality or part, are absent from other versions and translations.

We affirm that "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works" (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

We affirm that the Word of God is perfect (Psalm 18:30), inspired (2 Timothy 3:16), and inerrant (Psalm 12:6 & 119:140, Proverbs 30:5); belief in this truth is essential for the man of God to have the power and authority to proclaim the Word of God.
