- ◇ **Eligibility is based on individual choice**
- ◇ **Supported employment is integrated with treatment**
- ◇ **Competitive employment is the goal**
- ◇ **Job search starts soon after an individual expresses interest in working**
- ◇ **Follow-along support is continuous**
- ◇ **Individual preferences are important**
- ◇ **Personalized benefits counseling is important**
