

## What Will Happen If The Noxious Weeds Are Not Controlled?

We will make several attempts to contact the landowner to achieve control. If there is inadequate or no control when we return to survey at the specified time, landowners may be issued a "Notice to Control" giving them 10 days (or 48 hours if weeds are in flower or seed) to control the noxious weeds. If the noxious weeds are not adequately controlled by the end of the time limit, the program is authorized by Washington's noxious weed law (RCW 17.10) to cause the control of the noxious weeds at the owner's expense and/or issue a non-traffic Civil Infraction whose penalties are assigned as described in the Schedule of Monetary Penalties (WAC 16-750-020).
