



The Stanly County Arts Council, Inc. Non-Discrimination Policy

The Stanly County Arts Council, its Executive Board Members, its Employees, and all of its Sub-Grantees are contractually committed to abide by federal regulations which bar discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, disability, age, or sex and which require accessibility for persons with disabilities.

The Stanly County Arts Council and its Sub-Grantees are required to conduct their operations in compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 and, where applicable, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972. The Stanly County Arts Council and Sub-Grant recipients, in relation to any approved and contracted Sub-Grant activities or projects, must also be in compliance with the Fair Labor Standards Act, which provides for minimum compensation to employees.

The Stanly County Arts Council Executive Board Members and Employees, and all Stanly County Arts Council Sub-Grantees must ensure that people with disabilities have access to both the location and content of all funded programs.


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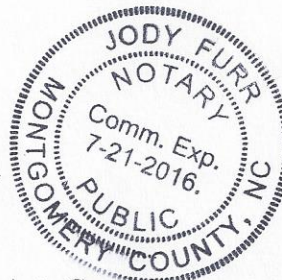
