a. Pat Hall reported the following:

i. There are currently 574 total registered players.

 - i. Current checking balance of \$32,203.09.
 - ii. Current savings of \$6,037.82.
 - iii. Total balance is \$38,240.91.

D. Pictures/Sponsor/ Fundraiser report:

- a. There are still plenty of handbooks in stock.

- c. BRYSL is currently at 31% of sponsors.

E. Fields/Golf Cart/Trailer Report:

F. Coach report:

- a. There are currently 60 teams formed.
- b. The following are some issues we are having with teams:
 - a. U06C – all teams have 8 players on the roster except one team has 7.
 - b. U08G4 – players are not showing up to practices
 - c. U08G5 – only 7 players on the roster, short 2 players
 - d. U08B3 – coach quit
 - e. U08B10 – only 7 players on the roster, no substitutions
 - f. U12B2 – only 8 players on the roster, short 1 player
 - g. U14C – 3 teams have 8 boys, 4 girls; one team has 9 boys, 3 girls
 - h. U19C – 3 teams have 8 boys, 4 girls; one teams has 9 boys, 3 girls

G. Referee report:

- a. There were 6 referees at the first clinic and 28 at the second clinic.
- b. There are currently 40 referees signed up.
- c. The bill for using the KCSF building was \$50.00.

H. Purchasing report:

 - i. On September 12th, Carolyn Morales motioned over email, Vanessa Radsick seconded, that BRYSL change the rules for the U12 Boys division to play 8 v. 8 until at least all teams have 10 players. There were 8 ayes, and 2 nays; motion passed with a majority vote.
