DESCRIPTION: At \$105.00, the Cascade was the most expensive hunting bow Shakespeare ever produced. Known as the "black beauty", the phenolic Cascade features 2" wide limbs. It is a great feeling and fantastic looking short hunting bow. Everything is original, and it is in near mint condition. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlay tips are in great condition. NO drilled holes. No stress lines or crazing. A few very minor scuffs on the limbs. This is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. In 2019 inflation-adjusted dollars, this bow would cost \$697 today.
