



So what is the Stoneybrook Parent School Council (SPSC)? And what do we do?

The SPSC is an advisory board comprised of parents, teachers, students and administration. We meet once a month to discuss policies & procedures, issues & concerns, school needs & how to meet them, academic goals & achievements. We work together, as an extended Stoneybrook Family to make great things happen for our students, teachers, school and community at large.

As mandated by the provincial government, Council holds nominations each fall. Watch for nomination forms to come home during the first week of school each year. If a sufficient number of parents or guardians express an interest in assuming a role on council, then an election may be required, though this is seldom the case.

The SPSC is comprised of up of 13 voting members, including 3-4 executive members; (co)-chair(s), secretary, and treasure; and 9 additional voting members with, or without portfolios. Occasionally, a position may be shared between 2 persons as a means to lighten the workload.

The entire Stoneybrook Student and Parent community is welcome to join us at our monthly meeting and contribute to our discussions, however only the voting members may cast votes for final decisions regarding polices, financial expenditures, project and events. Meetings are currently held on the second Wednesday of each month in the school library, at 7 p.m. and typically last 90 minutes.
