

“The Return”

We are excited to return to our sanctuary **Sunday, October 11th at 10:00 a.m.**

It has been a few months since we have been able to gather inside due to the limitations and regulations from the Ohio Department of health and the CDC regarding the Coronavirus 19 pandemic.

We are making strategic plans that will permit a glorious, meaningful, safe and compliant re-entry. This will be a phased re-entry *Sunday service only* at this time. Other activities will be phased in.

A lot has changed and it is our desire to make sure that you are well informed.

Masks and Safety Protocols: Masks are required for ALL individuals **2-years old and above**. Your mask must cover both your nose and mouth and remain in place the entire time you are in the building. All entering must sanitize their hands. Social distancing will be enforced. There will be physical markings on the floors to designate safe waiting distances.

You will be greeted at the door by members of Guest Services and Health Professional staffers. Your temperature will be checked at the door. If your temperature is **100 temperature or above**, you will not be permitted to enter. We will ask that you worship with us in-person at another time and to follow-up with your healthcare provider. **You will have to leave the building. If you are displaying any of the following symptoms: coughing, fever, shortness of breath or other symptoms, we request that you remain at home and enjoy the service from your home.**

Registration for Sunday services: We want to weekly prepare for our Calvary family and guests who will attend our worship service. To provide ample seating, we ask that you visit our website at www.calvary4u.org or call the Church Office @ 330.747.4445 to register **to attend each service**. You will be able to register **Tuesday, Wednesday** from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and **Friday** from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 pm.

Please Note: Registration will close at **2:00 p.m. on Friday, or when capacity has been met. Voicemails will not secure your registration.** While the Coronavirus 19 restrictions are in place, this will be our weekly procedure. The names on our registration list will be checked prior to your entry into the building. Your seat will be held until 10:30 AM, please let us know if you will be arriving later than 10:30 AM.

Parking Guidelines: We ask that you proceed to your vehicle with minimal conversation.

Entrance into the Building and Usage: Doors will open 1-hour before service. You will be welcomed by our Guest Services' and Health Professionals' staffers. Worshippers are welcomed to enter as long as they have a face covering which covers both their nose and mouth and they are free from fever or cough or other symptoms.

The Oak Hill Garden door *will be used primarily* for those individuals who are physically-challenged and in need of the elevator. All others are welcomed to enter through the Oak Hill Avenue doors.

Entrance into the sanctuary will be through rear double doors. **Once you are seated, please, No extra walking.**

Exiting from Service: Physically-challenged will exit *first* through the Oak Hill Avenue Garden stair case or elevator. **The balcony** will exit through either Regent Street stair well and doors; **rear of sanctuary** will exit through Regent Street doors when balcony exit is complete; **Front of sanctuary** will exit through front Oak Hill Avenue doors or Garden street door.

We must ask that there be no talking or conversing in sanctuary, in foyer or on the parking lot as you exit.

Cleaning and Sanitizing: Our cleaning team is using EPA- approved cleaning solutions and we have installed multiple hand-sanitizing stations throughout the building.

Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized regularly. **Only two persons at a time or a family group will be permitted in the restrooms at a time.**

Water fountains will not be available but we will try to have bottled water available.

Culinary services are discontinued until further notice.

Seating: Families that live/shelter/arrive together can sit together. Seating will begin front to back. Our Ministers of Order will direct you to your seat.

Giving of Tithes & Offering: Members and visitors desiring to give tithes and offerings, please continue to give via CashApp \$MTCyoungstown, Givelify or PayPal to Mt. Calvary Pentecostal Church. Deacons will be available to facilitate in-person giving with limited personal contact in the foyer; offering receptacles & envelopes will be at the Oak Hill Garden door and the main Oak Hill doors.

Altar Evangelists & Baptismal Attendants: After the Message, there will be specific prayers offered for salvation, finances, restoration, family, etc. Worshippers will stand at their seat or raise their hand for additional prayer.

Spontaneous **baptisms** will continue. Baptisms can be scheduled permitting adequate time for cleaning and physical distancing (either after service or during the week).

Prayer Ministry: Prayer preparation of Campus (parking lot and Church) for re-entry will be handled by the prayer team. Daily Prayer will continue:
