Description: The EMT program is designed to educate students to the US DOT requirements to become licensed as an Emergency Medical Technician in the State of Maine, and certified by the National Registry of EMT's. Labs include: Airway Management, Patient Assessment, Trauma Care and Medical Emergencies. Students who complete the course with a 75% average are eligible to participate in the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) psychomotor exam and sit for the NREMT and cognitive exam.

Classes will run every Tuesday and Thursday, 5 PM to 9PM and **Saturdays September 8th & 22nd, October 6th & 20th, November 3rd & November 17th, December 1st** from 8AM to 5 PM.
