PRIORITY DISCUSSION LIST

1. Roman Oben Flag Football Program Presentation

Roman Oben introduced himself and gave his presentation on his Flag Football Program to the Recreation Committee members and others present at the meeting. Registration for the summer program will start on April 15th. The program will be from July 29th-August 1st from 9am-12:30pm. Roman will be emailing the exact curriculum to Secretary V. Galizia within the next week. The program mainly focuses on fundamental football instruction and is no contact. It's a co-ed program and is ages 1st-7th grade. The coaches provided to oversee the program are highly trained and have background checks done on all of them. The coaches will be local coaches from around the area; parents or recreation coaches. Roman will also be present 3-4 times that week.

D. Coranoto asked that Roman send his insurance policy to the Township to look over prior to the program starting.

Advertising is being done on the Hampton website, Obenflagfootball.com, and flyers are sent home with the children at McKeown School.
