PTA General Meeting April 18, 2016

Call to Order: Robin Osterhout, PTA President, called the meeting to order at 9:38AM

Attendance: Robin Osterhout, Christi Brubaker, Amy Roundtree, Johannah Evans, Mary Mclean, Jacqueline Gay, Shelley Teras

Minutes: There was not a quorum to vote on the March 14, 2016 meeting minutes. On May 2nd, we will vote on the March 14th and April 18th meeting minutes.

Treasurer's Report: Robin gave the treasurer's report and passed out a copy for all in attendance. She noted that the Sports Camp, Color Run, and Yearbook deposits were all pending.

Update: Robin advised that we have nominees for all Board positions except VP of Education. Amy Roundtree described the job in more detail: setting up assemblies, after school activities, school supplies, Science Quest, Sports Camp, and sit on the Human Relations Committee. The person should have organizational and diplomatic skills.

Vice President Committee Chairs Reports:

Amy Roundtree, VP of Education reports that the refrigerator for the food pantry has been ordered and the cost is approx \$500. Also a cooler has been ordered for transporting the dairy items to WFCM. All of the volunteer transportation spots has been filled except one. The Human Relations Committee's will start a summer reading program in which teachers (or parent volunteers) will go once a week to the Meadows neighborhood to read/hand out books for approx 2 hours in the morning (before the pool opens). The Committee is sponsoring a Book Drive to support this endeavor. Book Drive will begin April 25th.

- **Johannah Evans, VP of Social** reports there were \$500 in sales at the door at the Volleyball game - very successful. Movie night is scheduled for May 6th. Teacher's Appreciation Week start on May 2nd and Admin Appreciation week begins on April 25.
- **Christi Brubaker, VP of Fundraising** reports that we have 464 Color Run registrations thus far compared to 402 last year. Also, there were 27 faculty members signed up last year compared to 48 this year. And we had \$3000 in sponsorships last year compared to

\$5000 this year. The team is working with police to get enough officers scheduled. Also, Ciro's night brought in \$200.

Robin Osterhout, PTA President reports the summer camp is full.
