
Wednesday, July 5

From the Pastor



Over the last nine months, going all the way back to October and to my time in Paris, Illinois, I have been doing an online FB devotion on

the book of Psalms; and we still have a ways to go in the book. Over the last couple of weeks, we were in Psalm 119, the longest psalm in the Bible. The theme of Psalm 119 is on the essential nature of God's word in the life of the believer. If we are going to understand how to live as God's people, what to do as God's people and how to relate to others as God's people, the Bible has to be our source and motivation. We learn how to be God's people from the scriptures.



On Sundays, we are working our way through.

This coming Sunday and for the next three Sundays, I Timothy and Psalm 119 are going to collide. For the next three weeks on Sunday mornings, we

will be talking about how godliness is related to our view and application of the Bible in our lives. Within the context of combating false teaching in the church, Paul gives Timothy three instructions - preach the Word, practice the Word and progress (grow) in the Word. Any church that seeks to be committed to God's call must be a church that focuses on the Bible and on the belief that the Bible, as God's word, is true. I hope to see you in church.
