RICARDO E. CASTILLO, 79, of TINTON FALLS

RICARDO E. CASTILLO, 79, of TINTON FALLS, passed away Wednesday, June 25, at Jersey Shore University Medical Center, Neptune. Born in Puerto Rico, he graduated in 1952 from the school of Pharmacy at the University of Puerto Rico. He served in the Air Force from 1951 to 1955, and operated his own pharmacy in Santurce, Puerto Rico from 1957 to 1975.
