

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER TWENTY SEVEN APPROVED JUNE 2ND 1915 BY ADDING SECTIONS NUMBER SIX AND SEVEN WHICH SECTIONS PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE AND DISPLAYING OF MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Owensville Missouri as follows:

Section 1-- The license collector, upon payment of the motor vehicle license by any person, shall issue to such person without charge a metal license plate having cast thereon the number of the plate in Arabic numerals, together with the words Owensville, Missouri, and the year for which the license is issued. The collector to be authorized by the Board of Aldermen to purchase and have on hand the required number of license plates at the beginning of the year. The said plate shall not exceed 3 inches in diameter. (Ordinance 27, Section 6.)

Section 2-- The license/^{plate} herein provided for shall be at all times conspicuously displayed on the front of the motor vehicle, securely fastened so as to prevent the same from swinging. (Ordinance 27, Sec. 7.)

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage and approval of same.
