Also, if you need a gift card, it is also available online. You can just print from your home printer and then it's available instantly for a last-minute gift idea!



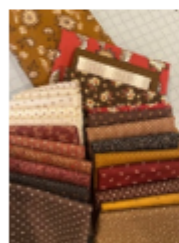
