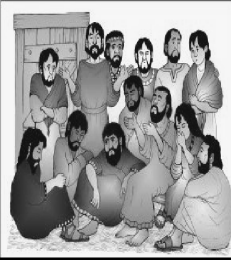
The Story of Pentecost
