#### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

**November 10, 1964** Secretary of Defense McNamara says, at a news conference that the U.S. has no plans to send combat troops into Vietnam; when asked whether the U.S. intends to increase its activities in Vietnam, he replies, "wait and see."

**November 10-20, 1965** The U.S. 1st Cavalry Division and ARVN troops launch Operation Silver Bayonet in Pleiku Province, II Corps, a follow-up operation to the clash at the Plei Me Special Forces camp. The purpose of the operation is to seek out and destroy Communist forces operating in the Ia Drang Valley.

**November 13-30, 1967** 7th Marine Regiment & Marine Special Landing Force Bravo carry out Operation Foster/Badger Hunt in retaliation for Viet Cong raids in Dai Loc & An Hoa areas, Quang Nam Province, I Corps.

**November 22, 1972** The U.S. loses the first B-52 to be brought down by a North Vietnamese surface-to-air missile (SAM) near Vinh on the day when B-52s fly their heaviest raids of the war over North Vietnam. The Communists claim 19 B-52s shot down to date.

**November 13, 1982** The Vietnam Veterans Memorial is dedicated in Washington, D.C. in memory of the 57,939 (at that time) U.S. soldiers killed or missing in the Vietnam War. This dedication is attended by more than 100,000 Vietnam Veterans.

**November 11, 1984** The Three Soldiers sculpture was dedicated. It represents the diversity of the military. The three men represent Caucasian, African American and Latino soldiers.

**November 11, 1993** The Vietnam Women's Memorial is dedicated to those women who served during the Vietnam War; it is positioned near the Vietnam Veterans Memorial.
