

## FAQs for Harry Potter Academic Conference Attendees

1. My friend still needs to register! Can he/she register on site at the college?

Yes, there will be computers set up at the "On Site Registration" table. You can pay the registration fee (\$15) using a credit card through our online system. Cash is not accepted.

2. Where can I park?

See the "Parking" link at [www.harrypotterconference.com](http://www.harrypotterconference.com) for full information, including handicapped parking. Generally there is parking available at Chestnut Hill College and at our nearby Sugarloaf campus. (Make sure to park in a legal parking spot that is **not** designated for official use, such as "green sticker" parking or "faculty/staff parking.") Parking on campus is free on Friday, but there is a \$10 charge (per car) on Saturday. Parking is expected to be more challenging on Saturday because of the Quidditch Tournament and the Wands & Wizards Festival.

3. What do I do when I arrive at the conference?

Follow the signs to the conference. Pick up your name badge and a copy of the program, then enjoy the conference!

4. Is there someplace I can eat lunch?

On Friday, there will be two food trucks outside the conference where you can buy your lunch. (While vegetarian options are available, we suggest bringing a bagged lunch if you have specific dietary concerns.) On Saturday, there will be vendors selling food by the Quidditch tournament and many food options in town at the Wands & Wizards festival. Show your conference name badge - many merchants are offering discounts!

5. Can I wear a costume?

At the Harry Potter Academic Conference, you'll see everything from suits and business attire to full costumes. The choice is yours.
