<u>Administration</u> – Allows a person to organize people and resources for greater efficiency, effectiveness and success.

<u>Apostleship</u> – Compels people to reach out to new and unfamiliar groups and individuals to invite them into relationship with God and community.

<u>Compassion</u> – Moves people to action on behalf of those in need.

Discernment – A gift of deep intuition and insight.

Evangelism – The gift of faith-sharing and proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ to those we meet.

Exhortation -Offering encouragement, wise counsel, unflaggin support and empowerment.

<u>Faith</u> – More than just a belief in Jesus Christ, but an abiding foundation of confidence that God works all things together for good and that the people of God can rise above any obstacle.

<u>Giving</u> – The deep communitment to provide whatever resources are needed to support God's will and plan.

<u>Healing</u> – The ability to channel God's grace and healing love to those who suffer physical, emotional or spiritual pain.

<u>Helping</u> – Providing the support and behind-the-scenes effort that make groups, families and congregations more effective.

<u>Interpretation of Tongues</u> – Those gifted to interpret tongues help build bridges across cultural, general and language divides.

<u>Knowledge</u> – Allows people to convert facts, data and information into useful and important knowledge.

<u>Leadership</u> – A visionary and forward-looking gift that enables people to stay focused on where God might be leading us as individuals, congregation, and a community at any given time.

<u>Miracles</u> – Those gifted with miracles never doubt the power and presence of God in creation and are able to help others see and believe in God's power.

<u>Prophecy</u> – The ability to speak God's word to others, or more appropriately to be open for God to speak God's word through us.

<u>Servanthood</u> – Doing for others, sometimes to the exclusion of meeting personal needs.

<u>Shepherding</u> – Mentoring and providing spiritual guidance to others to help them develop in discipleship and faith formation.

<u>Teaching</u> – Allows people to transform data and information into life-changing knowledge.

<u>Tongues</u> – A communication gift that allows people to speak foreign languages and convey concepts they never formally studied.

<u>Wisdom</u> – Allows people to understand deeper meaning and apply knowledge, beliefs and experience to everyday situations.
