Just so you are aware we are now living at 1701 B Coventry Ct. This will be around three months or until our house is completed. Our mailing address is still the same we will pick up our mail from there. We were having a roof replaced and the shingles and felt were off they had replaced the felt and were going to shingle the next day. That was the



night we had the high winds and heavy rains. At 6 to 7 inches came in through the ceilings and light fixtures. The contractors insurance company said they would take complete responsibility for the damage and had an adjustor come out to look at it. The roof contractor was there when he came out and said that this person did not have a clue about water damage all he wanted was out. His estimate came in at just over \$12,000.00 we sent the check back right away. As of today the total is at \$124,000.00 and still more to be added. 
