Town of Grant, Portage County
10 Ton/ 6 Ton Weight Limit Ordinance No. 2015-01

The Town Board of the Town of Grant, Portage County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.16, Wis. Stats. to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, establishes special weight limits as follows:

1. The following special weight limits of six (6) tons per one axle and ten (10) tons per two axles shall be effective on the following Town of Grant roads:

2. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall erect signs as required under s. 349.16(2), Wis. Stats, on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
3. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the above-noted weight limits without a written permit issued by the Town Board of the Town of Grant. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$1,000.00, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relieve from a court of record to enjoin further violations.


This ordinance is effective on September 15, 2015(a specific date after the date of publication of posting date, allowing adequate time for erection of signs)].

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis. Stats.


