No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.

This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed.

Comes with a serviceable Hoyt flex rest, and a new string.

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This bow sold for \$115 in 1962, which translates to \$1,159 in 2024 inflation adjusted dollars.
