Who am I? By Dietrich Bonhoeffer

Who am I? They often tell me I would step from my cell's confinement calmly, cheerfully, firmly, like a squire from his country-home.

Who am I? They often tell me I would talk to my warders freely and friendly and clearly, as though it were mine to command.

Who am I? They also tell me I would bear the days of misfortune equably, smilingly, proudly, like one accustomed to win.

Am I then really all that which other men tell of? Or am I only what I know of myself, restless and longing and sick, like a bird in a cage, struggling for breath, as though hands were compressing my throat, yearning for colours, for flowers, for the voices of birds, thirsting for words of kindness, for neighbourliness, trembling with anger at despotisms and petty humiliation, tossing in expectation of great events, powerlessly trembling for friends at an infinite distance, weary and empty at praying, at thinking, at making, faint, and ready to say farewell to it all?

Who am I? This or the other? Am I one person today, and tomorrow another? Am I both at once? A hypocrite before others, and before myself a contemptibly woebegone weakling? Or is something within me still like a beaten army, fleeing in disorder from victory already achieved?

Who am I? They mock me, these lonely questions of mine. Whoever I am, thou knowest, O God, I am thine.

This poem was a part of the letters and papers recovered from Dietrich Bonhoeffer's time in a Nazi prison. He had been in prison for nearly a year at the time of writing. Though at this point he still had hope of getting out of prison, perhaps through liberation from the Allies, we hear how this time has taken a toll on him and caused him to question himself. 'Who am I?' He asks over and over, trying to reconcile other's impression of him versus how he felt within.


Midweek Fellowship Dates

While most of us cannot identify with his experience as a prisoner, his poem can connect with our own circumstances. Who among us hasn't wondered about themselves and about how others see them? Often times the way we see ourselves is vastly different than the way others see us, and we can wonder who we really are. Who among us hasn't felt weary at times from the circumstances of life: illness, job changes, life stage transitions, aging, success and failure.

Life can leave us to wrestle with who we are especially if we are wrestling alone. At times, what we project to the world around us is vastly different than how we feel on the inside. This poem underscores the importance of life together in the body of Christ and the connection and support it brings. Because our self-perception can be skewed and life events can weigh heavily upon us God has designed us for and gifted us with community. Yet, there will be times where even the support of brothers and sisters will fall short. Therefore, we must remember that it is ultimately only God who holds the answer to the question 'Who am I?' Like Bonhoeffer, we must finally let our questions about ourselves and about our futures find their answer in God, because he has claimed us and we are His. 'Whoever I am, thou knowest, O God, I am thine.'


