Notes

Since 2019 we have increased the number of categories by 10 for a total of 52. Four in aircraft, three in Military Vehicles, one in ships, one in Real space and Science Fiction and one in juniors. This is in line with other contests in the western parts of the country. Increase of 1 Best of award (Miscellaneous)

The Miscellaneous and Hypothetical classes have been combined. It will now be the Miscellaneous class with 2 categories, Miscellaneous and Hypothetical. This is how the national is organized and it also allows these two to have access to a best of award which is now added to the “Best Of...”s list and consideration for best in show where as in previous years they didn’t.

Previous Modelzona contests have had 42 categories with 27 splits. With this new reorganization we have more natural categories that will hopefully help the entrants with model placement and hopefully lessen the need for splits. While staying on budget this still leaves 17 splits that can be used contest wide.

Scales have been listed in the most common available. If an entrant has a model that is out of the norm then it will be placed in the category that most closely represents its nearest competitor.
